On June 09, 2017 an inspection was conducted by Halton Region Health Department staff and a member of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario. The results of the inspection identified that an immediate health hazard was present due to the failure to reprocess equipment and devices used in patient care services. A verbal order was issued to cease and desist all patient care services until infection prevention and control (IPAC) practices were in compliance with the Ontario IPAC standards. Compliance with the standards prevents potential transmission of an infectious disease to patients and staff members. A written order was issued on June 13, 2017.
